

1. S 437 Veterans Burn Pits Exposure Recognition Act of 2021
To amend title 38, United States Code, to concede exposure to airborne hazards and toxins from burn pits under certain circumstances, and for other purposes. <https://www.congress.gov/bill/117th-congress/senate-bill/437/text>
2. S.657 — 117th Congress (2021-2022)
A bill to modify the presumption of service connection for veterans who were exposed to herbicide agents while serving in the Armed Forces in Thailand during the Vietnam era, and for other purposes. <https://www.congress.gov/bill/117th-congress/senate-bill/657/text>
3. S.810 - Fair Care for Vietnam Veterans Act of 2021
This bill provides a presumption of service-connection for hypertension and monoclonal gammopathy of undetermined significance (MGUS) for veterans who served in Vietnam between January 9, 1962, and May 7, 1975. Under a presumption of service-connection, specific conditions diagnosed in certain veterans are presumed to have been caused by the circumstances of their military service. Health care benefits and disability compensation may then be awarded.
